- 1. Overall GPA of 3.0/4.0
- 2. Junior standing or above (60+ credits at beginning of internship); enrolled full-time
- 3. Unpaid/minimally paid internship (Paid \$500 per month or less)
- 4. 0-9 academic credits with supervision by Augustana faculty or staff
- 5. Full-time placements considered: Professional, collegiate or amateur sports organization (not high school); sport event management or marketing or related field; sport management, sports agent, or sports marketing agency or related field.
- 6. Internship placement within continental USA
