- WHEREAS, gifts by alumni and friends of the college, coupled with earnings from the Augustana endowment, serve to enrich and support the educational experiences of every student; and
- WHEREAS, support from such sources not only reduces the cost of attending Augustana, but also provides financial resources for special learning experiences and opportunities, such as the annual Celebration of Learning, many research and service-learning programs in the U.S. and abroad, athletics, music, fine arts and other programs; and
- WHEREAS, Augustana's full tuition price has never equaled the total cost of an Augustana education, which is underwritten by the financial contributions of alumni and friends, foundations and businesses, as well as church and government sources; and
- WHEREAS, such investment in Augustana's students and their education grants to those students freedom from paying the entire cost of attending one of America's leading liberal arts colleges; and
- WHEREAS, in this, Augustana's sesquicentennial year, such non-tuition support of Augustana accounts for 18 percent of the instructional budget of the college; and
- WHEREAS, on April 12, 2010, 79 days remain in the 2009-2010 Augustana College academic year, and all of the learning experiences that challenge and inspire Augustana students throughout those 79 days may be considered funded by the aggregate contributions of the college's supporters; therefore be it
- RESOLVED, that in thanks to those who commit their financial resources in support of Augustana College and its mission of providing a challenging education that develops qualities of mind, spirit and body necessary for a rewarding life of leadership and service, all members of the Augustana College community be encouraged to pause and be mindful of their collective debt of gratitude for such dedicated and steadfast generosity; and be it further
