Vikings will still be young in 2012 but much more experienced

Veteran Augustana softball coach Kris Kistler knows that her softball team gained valuable experience in 2011. She hopes that translates back to the kind of success that the Vikings have become accustomed to since Kistler took over the program prior to the 2000 season.

"There were a whole lot of freshmen on the field last year," Kistler said with a chuckle about her team's adventures in 2011. "An awful lot of our players gained some valuable experience and the mental toughness that we gained collectively will be a huge factor toward out success this year. The talent level is fine and hopefully we have learned how to compete game-in and game-out."

Augustana went 19-19 a year ago and 5-9 in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin. It was the first losing season in conference play in Kistler's previous 12 seasons and the Vikings failed to post an overall winning record for the first time since 1999.

Just one year removed (2010) from the school's fifth NCAA Division III tournament appearance, Kistler figures her team has the tools to get back to its accustomed status. A total of 14 letter winners return, including five position players and two pitchers who could be considered starters.

"As is usually the case in softball, pitching will be the key," said Kistler, who has compiled an overall record of 342-175-2 (.661) during her 12 seasons as Augustana's head coach. "Our pitching staff is young but very talented. They have had a year under their belts so we expect them to be much better."

A year ago the Vikings logged a total of 244 1/3 innings on the mound and four players who accounted for 206 2/3 of those return for the 2012 season. Sophomore Sarah Hintz (LeRoy HS, LeRoy, III.) was the workhorse as a freshman when she posted an 8-7 record and a 2.17 earned run average in 116 innings of work. She had 78 strikeouts and walked just 26. Ashley Yaros (Stagg HS, Palos Hills, III.), another sophomore, led the team in victories last year when she was 9-5 and had a 3.32 ERA in 71 2/3 innings with 52 strikeouts and 34 base-on-balls.

Two more sophomores: Jaime Rehmert (Sterling HS, Sterling, III.) and Courtney Ledezma (United Township HS, East Moline, III.) will also be counted on. Rehmert was injured on the spring trip to Florida and she only logged 3 1/3 innings. Ledezma was injured during the early portion of the season and only saw action in relief during the second half of the campaign. She made 13 appearances and worked 15 2/3 innings while posting a 1.34 earned run average.

Two starters return in the infield but there is no guarantee either sophomore Kelsey Winter (United Township HS, East Moline, III.) or Krista Watson (Coal City HS, Coal City, III.) will be in the same position this year. Winter started 14 games at second base and she batted .277 with 13 hits in 47 at-bats. Watson started 33 games a year ago, mostly at shortstop and she batted .377 with 40 hits in 106 at-bats while scoring 29 runs with seven doubles, nine home runs and 25 runs-batted-in. She was the team's "Best Offensive Player" and was a first team all-conference performer.



The outfifeld will be bolstered by the return of fifth year senior Dawn Kernich, who was an all-conference performer during the 2010 season.



Senior Jillian Gibbs returns in left field to lead the Vikings into the 2012 season. She hit .287 with 16 runs, a homerun and 25 RBI last year in her first season in a Viking uniform.

The first base candidates will be Ledezma, Rehmert and freshman Christie Wiersema (Morrison HS, Morrison, Ill.) while Winter will battle freshman Jenna Teson (Jacobs HS, Algonquin, Ill.) at second base. Watson will probably be at shortstop but if she moves to third base then Teson will probably nail down the shortstop position. Junior Jenna Nelson (Orion HS, Orion, Ill.), sophomore Chaney Tambling (Dwight HS, Dwight, Ill.) and freshman Julie Sobieski (St. Charles East HS, St. Charles, Ill.) will be candidates at third base. Nelson was the regular designated hitter a year ago and she batted .378 with 37 hits in 98 at-bats with eight doubles, three home runs and 22 RBI. She was a first team all-region selection as a DH. Tambling hit .269 in limited action last year.

In the outfield senior Jillian Gibbs (Rock Island HS, Rock Island, Ill.) and sophomore Lauren Schneiderbauer (Sterling HS, Sterling, Ill.) are both returning starters. Gibbs was in left field where she hit .287 with 25 hits in 87 at-bats with 16 runs scored, two doubles, a home run and 16 RBI. Schneiderbauer played center and batted .262 with 17 hits in 65 at-bats with 14 runs scored, one double, one triple, three home runs and 12 RBI. She also tied for the team lead in stolen bases with eight. A wild card in the outfield will be fifth-year senior Dawn Kernich (Mt. Olive HS, Mt. Olive, Ill.), a former first team all-conference performer who missed the entire 2011 season due to a knee injury.

Senior Abbi Staples (Sterling HS, Sterling, III.), junior Rachel Russell (Hinsdale South HS, Willowbrook, III.), sophomore Bria Snyder (Lincoln-Way East HS, Frankfort, III.) and freshman Chelsea Lavin (Downers Grove South HS, Downers Grove, III.) will also battle for playing time in the outfield.

Sophomore Randi Applehans (Mountain Vista HS, Highlands Ranch, Colo.) handled most of the catching responsibilities last year when she batted .224 in 29 games. Freshman Jaclyn Wrona (Glenbard South HS, Wheaton, III.) could be in the mix as well.

The Vikings will once again tackle an ambitious schedule and Kistler hopes her team can get off to a fast start on the annual trip to Florida over spring break.

"Even though we have lots of returners, we have plenty of youth so confidence is always an issue," said Kistler. "We know we can compete with anybody on our schedule. We need to believe we can win close games and I think we can do that."

Kris Kistler has been the head softball coach at Augustana College for the past 12 years and she has established the Vikings as a legitimate power in both the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin and NCAA Division III. She has guided the Blue & Gold to 11 straight winning seasons, something that had never happened before around the Augustana campus. The Vikings have also won at least 30 games in five of the last eight years and six times since 2000.

Three times in the last seven years Kistler has led the Vikings to the CCIW tournament championship and four times her teams have qualified for a berth in the NCAA Division III national tournament. In 2004 she guided Augustana to the first conference championship in softball in school history and the Vikings were 36-9 and placed third in the NCAA Great Lakes Regional. Augustana set a total of 10 school records in that historic 2004 campaign. The 2006 team was 33-10 overall, won the CCIW with a 13-1 overall mark, and swept the conference tournament en route to earning a host spot for the NCAA Great Lakes Regional. Eight school records fell in 2006. The 2007 team went 30-14, finished second in the conference regular season and won the CCIW tournament to again advance to the NCAA playoffs. Eight new school records were established in 2007.

Sandwiched between the 2004 and 2006 seasons was a fine 33-12 campaign in which the Vikings were 11-3 in the CCIW and finished second in the conference tournament. The 2008 team went 26-18, finished fourth in the conference regular season, and advanced to the CCIW Tournament title game. In 2009 Augustana was 28-14 overall and 9-5 in the CCIW. 2010 marked another successful season for the Vikings as they compiled a 31-15 record en route to a second place finish in the CCIW tournament and a birth in the NCAA Division III national tournament. In 2010 the Vikings were 31-15 and made it to the NCAA tournament for the fourth time since 2004.

Kistler wasted no time getting the Vikings turned around after inheriting a program that had enjoyed just one winning season in the previous eight years. After being hired in September of 1999 to replace longtime head coach Diane Schumacher, she was left with precious little time to get ready for the 2000 season. It didn't seem to matter as she led her team to a school record for victories in a single season with a 30-15 overall mark. Included in that was an 8-6 record in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin and a championship in the Augustana Invitational. That team was loaded with seniors and it looked like 2001 would be a rebuilding year for the Vikings, but Kistler managed to quide them to a 23-20-1 record.

In 2002 her team finished 27-15 and placed third in the CCIW, both in regular season play and in the tournament. At the time the 27 victories tied for the second highest total in school history with teams from 1980 (27-9) and 1996 (27-14). The 2003 squad was 26-14-1 overall and 8-6 record in the conference.

In 12 seasons at Augustana she has compiled a record of 342-174-2 for a winning percentage of .662 and her CCIW mark is 107-61 (.636) in that same time span. Since she started she has coached 41 first team all-conference performers and 42 all-region selections. Twice, in her first season of 2000 and again in 2004, she has been named the CCIW "Coach of the Year" and in 2006 and again in 2007 the Augustana coaching staff was named "Coaching Staff of the Year"

After graduating from Monmouth High School in Monmouth, Illinois, Kistler went on to have a fine collegiate career at Eureka College in Eureka, Illinois where she helped the Red Devils to a career record of 91-57 including a school record 30-7 mark in 1996. Eureka was in the NAIA playoffs three years and Kistler made the 1994 NAIA all-district tournament team. She was named her team's Best Defensive Player in 1996 and she graduated with a career batting average of .346 with a single season high of .394 in 1996.

A multiple sport athlete, she also played basketball for four years at Eureka and was an all-conference selection in 1994-95 in the Chicagoland Collegiate Athletic Conference. She was team MVP and co-captain in 1995-96.

After graduation from Eureka she went to Illinois State University where she obtained her master's degree in 1998 in Health, Physical Education and Recreation with a specialization in Exercise Physiology. During that time she served as an assistant softball coach at Illinois Wesleyan University where she helped

lead the Titans to a 52-25 overall record and the 1997 College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin championship.

Kistler spent the 1998-99 school year as the head coach as Plattsburgh State University in Plattsburgh, New York where she was charged with starting a varsity program. She led her team to a 9-10 season in the Cardinals inaugural campaign. She also served as an assistant coach in basketball. In addition to her duties as head softball coach at Augustana, Kistler also serves as the senior women's administrator for the athletic department.

ASSISTANT COACH DAVE HEBBELN

Dave Hebbeln, of Davenport, Iowa, will begin his tenth year on the Augustana softball staff. He replaced Denise Wojtkiewicz, who had been Kistler's number one assistant. Hebbeln was the head coach at Marycrest University from 1996 until 2002 until the school closed its doors for good. Prior to serving as the head coach he had two stints as an assistant for the Eagles (1978-80 and 1992-95). He has been involved in coaching the ASA Davenport Blazers in the summer.



PITCHING COACH JOHN BROKAW

John Brokaw is in his seventh year as the pitching coach for the Vikings. He coached at Orion High School as an assistant from 1991-05 and also served as the pitching coach at Momouth College for two years. He coached the A.S.A. "Quad City Firebirds" for 16 seasons from 1988-04. A native of Lynn Center, Illinois, Brokaw retired from Case/IH in East Moline in 2001 after a 30 year career as a welder.



ASSISTANT COACH LEANN BARBER

Leann Barber, who enjoyed an outstanding career with the Vikings, rejoins the program as an assitant coach. She was on the staff during a three year stretch from 2006-08 before taking a year off. This will be in her sixth year as an assistant coach. Barber, a four year letterwinner, was a first team all-conference selection three times, twice as a catcher and once at first base. She was also a

three time all-Midwest Region selection. She was on the top ten career list in four offensive categories when she graduated in the spring of 2005. A standout athlete at Moline High School, Barber has a degree in Sociology from Augustana.

Youthful Vikings finish year 19-19 overall and 5-9 in CCIW; Seniors finish their careers among Augustana's all-time statistical leaders

With a lineup that most often included five freshmen and an additional two players in their first year in the Augustana program, coach Kris Kistler's Augustana softball team finished the 2011 season with an overall record of 19-19 and a CCIW mark of 5-9. While this was the first of Kistler's 12 Viking teams not to achieve a winning record, the abilities of this year's youngsters point to a bright future. In addition, three of this year's Viking seniors finished their careers ranking prominently in several statistical categories. Senior outfielder Melissa Nelson (West Aurora HS, Aurora, III.) and freshman shortstop Krista Watson (Coal City HS, Coal City, III.) earned first team All-CCIW honors, while sophomore designated player Jenna Nelson (Orion HS, Orion, III.) was an NFCA first team All Paging solution. first team All-Region selection.

The Vikings won their first three games of the season in Florida before dropping their next three and were never more than three games over or two under .500 the entire season. Three of Augustana's five wins in CCIW play came against teams that qualified for the conference tournament, including a sweep of Wheaton in which Kistler got complete game shutouts from both halves of her 1-2 freshman pitching combo of Sarah Hintz (Leroy HS, Leroy, Ill.) and Ashley Yaros (Stagg HS, Palos Hills, Ill.).

Hintz, who was 8-7 on the year, led the team in ERA (2.17), appearances (25), starts (18), complete games (seven), innings pitched (116) and strikeouts (78). She shared the team's MVP award with Melissa Nelson. Yaros went 9-5 to lead the staff in wins and compiled a 3.32 earned run average. Hintz and Yaros each spun a pair of shutouts this season. Another freshman, Courtney Ledezma (United Township HS, East Moline, Ill.), worked her way back from injury to be the Vikings' top reliever by season's end. She was 0-2 in 13 appearances, but had an ERA of just 1.34.

Offensively, Watson missed winning the team's triple crown by one batting average point. She hit .377 with nine home runs and 25 runs batted in and won the Vikings' Best Offensive Player award. Her nine home runs are tied for the fourth highest single-season total in school history. She also led the team in runs scored (29), total bases (74) and slugging percentage (.698) and her 40 hits tied junior first baseman Christina Trojanowksi (Evergreen Park HS, Evergreen Park, Ill.) (.325-0-10) for the team lead. Watson was a first team All-CCIW selection after leading the league in home runs (five), total bases (33) and slugging percentage (.767).

Sophomore Jenna Nelson, another player in her first season with Augustana, led the Vikings with a .378 batting average and a .425 on-base percentage. She was second with eight doubles, tied for second with three home runs and ranked third on the club with 37 hits, 22 RBI and a .551 slugging percentage. The National Fast Pitch Coaches Association made her a first team All-Great Lakes Region selection.

Other freshman regulars for Kistler this season included centerfielder Lauren Schneiderbauer (Sterling HS, Sterling, Ill.) (.262-3-12, team-high eight stolen bases), second baseman Kelsey Winter (United Township HS, East Moline, Ill.) (.277-0-6)—who was selected the Vikings' Most Improved Player—and catcher Randi Applehans (Mountain Vista HS, Highlands Ranch, Colo.) (.224-0-6). Junior outfielder Jillian Gibbs (Rock Island HS, Rock Island, Ill.) hit .287 with one homer and 16 RBI in her first season at Augustana as well. She led the CCIW with eight sacrifices bunts.

Seniors Melissa Nelson, Stephanie Sarb (Lisle HS, Lisle, Ill.) and Sheldon Ritzheimer (Wesclin HS, Trenton, Ill.) each left her mark on the Augustana record book. Nelson finished the year with a .336 average, three homers and 20 RBI to share team MVP honors with Hintz. She led the team with nine doubles and four triples—the seventh-best single season total in school history—and ranks in the Augustana career top ten in seven offensive categories as well. Her 33 doubles are third all-time. She's fourth in career RBI (96), fifth in home runs (14) and at-bats (497), tied for seventh in triples (eight) and ninth in hits (156), and her 89 runs also rank ninth on the career list. Sarb, who anchored the hot corner for Augustana, hit .305 with two homers and 24 RBI this year and wraps up her career fourth on Augustana's all-time home run list with 15 and eighth in RBI with 77. In addition, she made just four errors in 108 chances at third base this year, fashioning a .963 fielding percentage and winning the team's Best Defensive Player award. Ritzheimer finished ninth in career pitching wins with 24, seventh in strikeouts at 197 and 10th in innings pitched with 228.

Kistler, the winningest coach in Augustana softball history, finishes her 12th season at the helm of the Vikings with a record of 342-175-2 (.661). Her overall collegiate record, including one year at SUNY-Plattsburgh is 351-185-2 (.654).



THE COLLEGE CONFERENCE OF ILLINOIS & WISCONSIN

Now in its 66th year, the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin (CCIW) enjoys a reputation as the "Best Small-College Conference in the Nation." The league was formed with nine charter members (Augustana, Carthage, Elmhurst, Illinois College, Illinois Wesleyan, Lake Forest, Millikin, North Central and Wheaton) on April 26, 1946 in Jacksonville, Illinois. Competition opened in the 1946-47 academic year as the College Conference of Illinois.

Carthage left the conference in 1952 but returned in 1961. In 1967 the name was changed to the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin to recognize Carthage, which had moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin from Carthage, Illinois in 1962, and Carroll, which entered the league in 1955.

As is often the case with athletic conferences, CCIW membership has experienced some changes since the league's inception. After Carthage left in 1952, Illinois College withdrew the following year. Elmhurst and Wheaton left following the 1959-60 academic year. Wheaton rejoined for all sports but football in 1967 and then for football in 1970. Elmhurst rejoined in the fall of 1967 for all sports but football and for football in the 1968 season. Carroll joined officially with the 1955 spring sports seasons. Carthage returned in 1961 and North Park entered the following fall. Lake Forest dropped out at the end of the 1962-63 year. The last change in CCIW membership came following the 1991-92 season when Carroll withdrew.

Now eight members strong, the CCIW continues its tradition of athletic and academic excellence. The league sanctioned women's sports for the first time in the 1986-87 school year and Augustana participated in the first ever women's competition. That was on September 14, 1986 when the Vikings met North Central in a volleyball match that was held at Elmhurst College.

The College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin sanctions 21 sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's golf, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's swimming, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's indoor track & field, men's and women's outdoor track & field, volleyball and wrestling.

Augustana will welcome its 11th women's varsity sport, lacrosse, for the 2011-12 season. Augustana will also be welcoming men's lacrosse as its 12th men's varsity sport for the 2012-13 season. Neither women's nor men's lacrosse is currently a CCIW sport.

Augustana owns more CCIW team championships than any other school in the league with 175 total. Of those 175, the men have won 137 and 38 belong to the women.

The CCIW began to award championships in softball starting in the 1986-87 school year. Augustana won its first league title in 2004, taking the regular season with an 11-3 record and winning the conference tournament with a 7-1 victory over North Central in the championship game.
