## About Augustana College

## HEAD COACH SCOTT JOHANNSEN

Scott Johannsen will begin his fifth year as the head coach of both the men and women's swim teams at Augustana for the 2012-13 school year. Johannsen put together a solid first four years in charge of both programs.

During the 2011-12 season, he led the Augustana men to a 4-3 dual meet record and a fifth place finish in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin.

The Vikings also finished third at the Pioneer Classic at Grinnell, and fourth at the Grinnell Invitational. The season was marked by the setting of six school records, and the naming of Johannsen as the CCIW male "Coach of the Year" for the second straight season. Over Johannsen's tenure, the men have set a total of eight new school records.

He also led the Augustana women to a 2-5 dual meet record and a fifth place finish in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin. The Vikings also finished second at the IWU Invite, seventh at the Pioneer Classic and eighth at the Grinnell Invite. The season also saw Augustana break four school records at the CCIW meet on February 16. The four new records brought the total under Johannsen to five.

"I am pleased that Scott Johannsen has accepted the head men and women's swim coach position at Augustana," said Mike Zapolski, director of athletics, at the time of his hiring in the summer of 2008. "At the beginning of this search, it was clear that establishing a higher level of commitment and continuity from a coaching perspective was critical. I believe that Scott has the expertise and passion to be a difference-maker for the future growth of swimming at Augustana. Scott is a Quad Cities native and a well-known commodity in the regional swimming community."

Johannsen has been the head coach of the Pleasant Valley Stingrays Swim Club from September of 2006. He was responsible for a club that had 150 swimmers. He is also the owner/manager of the Samax Corporation since 1994.

He was a standout swimmer at Davenport West High School where he became the first four year varsity letter winner in school history. He was a three time first team all-state performer in the 100 butterfly and held the school record in that event until 1996. He attended Western Illinois on a swimming scholarship and served as captain of the team. He was a two time finalist in the 100 butterfly in the Mid Continent Conference.

Prior to coaching the Stingrays, he was also the head coach of the Rock Island YMCA club team from 1987 through 1990.

He has been active in various youth programs throughout the Quad Cities and has served as the president of the Davenport Knights of Columbus and the John F. Kennedy Athletic Club. He was the vice president of the Kimberly Village Homeowner's Association in 2000-01.

**Vikings finish fifth at CCIW Championships; behind Emma Regnier, better four school records; Helen Myers wins conference titles in both diving events for second straight year**

ROCK ISLAND, Ill. – Sophomore Helen Myer's (Pecatonica HS, Rock City, Ill.) repeat championships in both the one and three-meter diving events, along with a pair of individual school records by junior Emma Regnier (Grayslake North HS, Lake Villa, Ill.) highlighted Augustana's performance at this year's College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin meet. Regnier was also a member of two record-setting relay teams as coach Scott Johannsen's women finished fifth in the team standings. Wheaton captured the team title with 899.5 points.

Myers opened the CCIW meet by winning the springboard and platform events in Bloomington, Illinois on Saturday, February 11. She won both titles for the second year in a row, compiling 343.20 points in the one-meter competition and 333.70 at three-meters.

The swimming portion of the meet commenced on Thursday, February 16 and ran through Saturday, February 18. One of Regnier's records came in the 100 butterfly, where she became the first woman in school history to break the one-minute barrier, swimming a :59.67. In medley competition, she swam a 50-yard butterfly leg of :27.02, also a new school standard. She swam the second leg of the Vikings' 400 freestyle relay, which set an Augustana record of 3:39.35 and the third leg on the 800 freestyle relay team, which finished in a school-record 8:03.77. She was joined on both relay units by juniors Molly Clennon (Benet Academy, Naperville, Ill.) and Alexandra Piper (Coal City HS, Coal City, Ill.) and sophomore Hillary Ferguson (Waubonsie Valley HS, Naperville, Ill.).

Both the 400 and 800 freestyle relays brought home fourth-place finishes from the conference meet. After Myers, Augustana's top individual finishes were Ferguson's fifth-place :24.79 in the 50 freestyle and Regnier's fifth-place 1:08.62 in the 100 breaststroke. Regnier was also seventh in the 200 butterfly (2:15.85) and ninth in the 100 butterfly. Ferguson was eighth in the 100 freestyle (:54.69) and junior Emily Timmons (West Aurora HS, North Aurora, Ill.) was ninth in the 400 individual medley (4:55.32). Clennon claimed a pair of 10th-place individual finishes with a 1:57.84 in the 200 freestyle and a 5:18.50 in the 500 freestyle.

The other Viking relay teams grabbed two fifth and one sixth-place finish. The 200 freestyle team of Piper, Regnier, Clennon and Ferguson was fifth in 1:40.58 and the quartet of Clennon, Timmons, Regnier and Ferguson was fifth in the 200 medley relay, swimming a 1:55.22. Freshman Beth Cole (Muscatine HS, Muscatine, Iowa), sophomore Elizabeth O'Hara (Westosha Central HS, Salem, Wis.), freshman Alexis Thompson (Crystal Lake Central HS, Lake in the Hills, Ill.) and sophomore Erin Doty (Oswego HS, Oswego, Ill.) captured sixth in the 400 medley relay with a time of 4:40.18.

The Vikings opened the season on October 29 with a 146-74 dual meet win over Millikin at Carver Center. Their next two meets were the Illinois Wesleyan Invitational and the Pioneer Classic at Grinnell College. They finished second of six teams, trailing only the hosts, at Illinois Wesleyan and were seventh in a 13-team field at Grinnell.

Augustana dropped a dual meet at Loras (131-100), came home to defeat Coe 142-95 and then fell at Luther 186-54.

On January 20 & 21, the Vikings competed at the Grinnell Invitational, finishing eighth in an 11-team field. They closed out the pre-conference meet schedule with three losses at the Monmouth quad. Western Illinois (131-120), Valparaiso (155-102) and Monmouth (133-120) all bested Augustana as the Vikings finished 2011-12 with a dual meet record of 2-5.

Four Vikings either debuted or moved up the school's top ten lists in a total of 11 events. In addition to Regnier's 100 butterfly record, her personal bests now rank second in the 200 butterfly (2:15.85) and 100 breaststroke (1:08.62) and fourth in the 200 individual medley (2:15.80). Clennon sits second in the 500 (5:18.50) and 200 (1:57.84) freestyles and is tied with Ferguson for fourth in the 100 freestyle (:54.50). Ferguson is also fourth with a :24.56 in the 50 freestyle. Timmons bests of 4:55.32 in the 400 individual medley and 2:18.62 in the 200 individual medley rank fourth and ninth, respectively, at Augustana.

**Vikings finish fifth at CCIW Championships for third straight season; Scott Johannsen shares CCIW "Coach of the Year"; Aaron Holt breaks four individual records and is a member of two school-record relays**

ROCK ISLAND, Ill. – With his men's team breaking six school records and bring home its third straight fifth-place conference finish, Augustana coach Scott Johannsen was named the CCIW's co-Coach of the Year for 2012. Freshman Aaron Holt (Mt. Vernon HS, Mt. Vernon, Ill.) was involved in all six school records, setting four individually and swimming on a pair of record-setting relays. The Vikings finished with 372.5 points at the conference meet. Carthage won the event with 920.5 points.

Holt set school standards in both the 100 (:52.50) and 200 (1:56.00) backstrokes as well as the 100 butterfly (:50.87) and 200 individual medley (1:55.62). The quartet of Holt, Ryan Chaney (Pleasant Valley HS, Bettendorf, Iowa), Chris Greaves (Morris HS, Morris, Ill.) and Daniel Hinck (Harlem HS, Loves Park, Ill.) broke the school mark in the 200 medley relay, swimming a 1:38.21 and Holt, Michael Duy (Marmion Academy, Aurora, Ill.), Charles Vogt (Oak Park-River Forest HS, Oak Park, Ill.) and Hinck set a new 400 freestyle relay record of 3:11.61.

Holt, with a :51.27 in the 100 butterfly and Hinck, with a 1:44.33 in the 200 freestyle, were Augustana's top finishers at the CCIW meet, with each grabbing second place. Holt was third in the 100 backstroke and fourth in the 200 individual medley (1:55.62). Freshman Josh Wielenga (School Environmental Study HS, Apple Valley, Minn.) was fourth in both the one (345.65) and three-meter (342.05) diving competition. Duy was 5th in the 200 freestyle (1:44.45), seventh in the 200 butterfly (2:02.40) and eighth in the 500 freestyle (4:47.84). Greaves was sixth in the 200 backstroke (2:00.34) and eighth in the 200 butterfly (2:03.76). Zarbuck finished eighth in the 1650 freestyle in a time of 17:19.94.

In the relay events, the Vikings finished third in the 400 freestyle, fourth in the 200 and 800 freestyles and 400 medley, and fifth in the 200 medley.

Johannsen's men opened the season with a 157-40 dual meet win over Millikin on October 29. On November 19, they traveled to Bloomington, Illinois and bested five other teams at the Illinois Wesleyan Invitational. Holt won the 100 butterfly and 200 IM, Greaves was a winner in the 200 freestyle and Hinck in the 100 freestyle. Wielenga captured the three-meter diving competition and the 200 freestyle relay (Duy, Vogt, Greaves and Hinck) was a winner as well.

Two weeks later at Grinnell's Pioneer Classic, Wielenga won both the springboard and platform events to help the Vikings take third in a 13-team field. The team sandwiched a dual meet win against Coe at home between losses at Loras and Luther.

On January 20 & 21, the Vikings competed in the Grinnell Invitational, finishing fourth among seven teams. Hinck (4:56.72 in the 500 freestyle) Holt (:52.98 in the 100 butterfly) and Zarbuck (17:58.96 in the 1650 freestyle) picked up individual wins.

Augustana won two of three duals at the Monmouth Quad, falling to Western Illinois 146-112 and defeating Valparaiso 138-115 and the host school 154-87. The Vikings finished 2011-12 with a dual meet record of 4-3.

In addition to Holt's school records, he cracked the Augustana all-time top ten in the 50 (8th with a :22.19) and 100 (9th with a :48.68) freestyles. Hinck and Duy etched their names on three top ten lists each. Hinck with a :47.25 in the 100 freestyle (2nd), a 1:44.33 in the 200 freestyle (3rd) and a 4:49.83 in the 500 freestyle (3rd) and Duy with a 4:46.83 in the 500 freestyle (2nd), a 1:45.44 in the 200 freestyle (4th) and a 2:02.40 in the 200 butterfly (5th). Chaney now sits fourth in the 200 breaststroke (2:17.32) and eighth in the 100 breaststroke (1:02.64). Greaves' best of 1:47.51 in the 200 freestyle ranks eighth at Augustana.

# Augustana men and women prepare for successful 2012-13 season

## MEN'S EVENT BREAKDOWN

**FREESTYLE** – Sophomore Aaron Holt (Mount Vernon HS, Mount Vernon, Ill.) broke on the scene in a big way in 2011-12 when he set four individual school records. He had the fastest time on the team in the 50 (:22.19) and 100 (:48.68) freestyle events. Those are the eighth and ninth best times in Augustana history. He will lead the sprint corps this year but will get help from junior Daniel Hinck (Harlem HS, Loves Park, Ill.). Hinck owns the second fastest time in school history in the 100 (:47.25) and third best in the 200 (1:44.33). Freshman Felipe Hernandez (United Township HS, East Moline, Ill.) will be used in a variety of the freestyle events and sophomore Tim Michaels (Pella HS, Pella, Iowa) will help out here as well.

In the middle and longer distance freestyle events Johannsen and the Vikings welcome back junior Justin Reppy (Oswego HS, Oswego, Ill.). Reppy was the CCIW champion in the 200, 500 and 1650 freestyle events as a freshman in 2010-11 before sitting out last season. He also owns the Augustana school record at each of those distances. Hinck will swim in the longer races as well and sophomore Michael Duy (Marmion Academy, Aurora, Ill.) was a CCIW placewinner a year ago. Senior captain Chris Greaves (Morris HS, Morris, Ill.) has enjoyed an outstanding career and will be a valuable contributor at a variety of distances. Junior Austin Zarbuck (Urbana HS, Urbana, Ill.) and Reppy will be a solid duo in the 1650.

**BREASTSTROKE** – Hernandez and junior Jasen Hengst (Bettendorf HS, Bettendorf, Iowa) will be solid in the breaststroke along with junior Ryan Chaney (Pleasant Valley HS, Bettendorf, Iowa). Johannsen thinks all three have the potential to place in the CCIW final.

**BUTTERFLY** – Holt is the school record holder in the 100 butterfly at :50.87 and he could challenge for a conference title in the event. Freshman David Sommers (Westlake HS, Thousand Oaks, Calif.) will also be a factor in the butterfly and his specialty is at the 200 meter distance. Freshman Adam Bernardi (Rockford Boylan Catholic HS, Belvidere, Ill.) is a solid performer also.

**BACKSTROKE** – Holt was a placewinner in both backstroke events at the CCIW meet as a freshman and he owns the school record in both the 100 (:52.50) and 200 (1:56.00). Hernandez will be right with Holt and freshmen Kyle Johnson (Shadow Mountain HS, Phoenix, Ariz.) and Austin Small (Morris HS, Morris, Ill.) make this a very deep event for the Vikings.

**INDIVIDUAL MEDLEY** – Holt and Somers once again give Augustana big point potential in any meet. Holt holds the school record in the 200 IM at 1:55.62). Bernardi and sophomore Alexander Putz (Oak Forest HS, Oak Forest, Ill.) will be used here as well.

**DIVING** – Sophomore Josh Wielenga (School Environmental Study, Apple Valley, Minn.) was fourth in both the one and three meter events last year in the CCIW meet. He returns for his sophomore season and has added some dives to his arsenal.

## WOMEN'S EVENT BREAKDOWN

**FREESTYLE** – The sprint freestyle events will be in the capable hands of junior Hillary Ferguson (Waubonsie Valley HS, Naperville, Ill.) and senior Alexandra Piper (Coal City HS, Coal City, Ill.). Both were members of the school record setting 400 (3:39.35) and 800 (8:03.77) and they will handle the shorter distances. Ferguson turned in the fourth fastest time in school history in the 50 (:24.65) and 100 (:54.50) freestyle events. Seniors Molly Clennon (Benet Academy, Naperville, Ill.) and Emma Regnier (Grayslake North HS, Lake Villa, Ill.) were the other two members on both school record setting relay teams. Clennon will swim the 200 and 500 freestyle and she just missed the school record in the 200 (1:57.84) and 500 (5:18.50) freestyles and she owns the fourth best 100 freestyle clocking (:54.50) in Augustana history. The distance freestyle events will have senior Emily Timmons (West Aurora HS, North Aurora, Ill.) and freshman Emma Novak (Eden Prairie HS, Eden Prairie, Minn.) along with junior Erin Doty (Oswego HS, Oswego, Ill.). Junior Catherine Pittman (Mahomet-Seymour HS, Mahomet, Ill.) has also been impressive during the early season workouts and she will factor in somewhere.

**BREASTSTROKE** – Regnier not only had a hand in two school records on relays last year but also turned in the second fastest time in school history in the 100 breaststroke. Sophomore Laura Pemberton (Fremont HS, Fremont, Neb.) and freshman Jordan Johnson (Appleton North HS, Appleton, Wis.) help make this an extremely deep event for the Vikings.

**BUTTERFLY** – Regnier is the school record holder in both the 50 (:27.02) and 100 (:59.67) butterfly events and has the second fastest all-time in the 200 at 2:15.86). She could get quite a push from Novak, who has looked very good in the early season workouts.

**BACKSTROKE** – Kabbe, sophomore Beth Cole (Muscatine HS, Muscatine, Iowa) and freshman Kristin Molloy (Buffalo Grove HS, Buffalo Grove, Ill.) will handle the backstroke events.

**INDIVIDUAL MEDLEY** – Regnier owns the fourth best time ever for the Vikings in the 200 IM with a 2:15.80 and she will be joined by Novak and Timmons in the individual medley.

**DIVING** – Junior Helen Myers (Pecatonica HS, Rock City, Ill.) is the two-time defending CCIW champion in both the one and three meter diving events and she will be joined by freshman Adelia Clark (Linn Mar HS, Marion, Iowa).

## THE COLLEGE CONFERENCE OF ILLINOIS & WISCONSIN

Now in its 67th year, the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin (CCIW) enjoys a reputation as the "Best Small-College Conference in the Nation." The league was formed with nine charter members (Augustana, Carthage, Elmhurst, Illinois College, Illinois Wesleyan, Lake Forest, Millikin, North Central and Wheaton) on April 26, 1946 in Jacksonville, Illinois. Competition opened in the 1946-47 academic year as the College Conference of Illinois.

Carthage left the conference in 1952 but returned in 1961. In 1967 the name was changed to the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin to recognize Carthage, which had moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin from Carthage, Illinois in 1962, and Carroll, which entered the league in 1955.

As is often the case with athletic conferences, CCIW membership has experienced some changes since the league's inception. After Carthage left in 1952, Illinois College withdrew the following year. Elmhurst and Wheaton left following the 1959-60 academic year. Wheaton rejoined for all sports but football in 1967 and then for football in 1970. Elmhurst rejoined in the fall of 1967 for all sports but football and for football in the 1968 season. Carroll joined officially with the 1955 spring sports seasons. Carthage returned in 1961 and North Park entered the following fall. Lake Forest dropped out at the end of the 1962-63 year. The last change in CCIW membership came following the 1991-92 season when Carroll withdrew.

Now eight members strong, the CCIW continues its tradition of athletic and academic excellence. The league sanctioned women's sports for the first time in the 1986-87 school year and Augustana participated in the first ever women's competition. That was on September 14, 1986 when the Vikings met North Central in a volleyball match that was held at Elmhurst College.

The College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin sanctions 21 sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's golf, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's swimming, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's indoor track & field, men's and women's outdoor track & field, volleyball and wrestling.

The latest sports added at Augustana were men's and women's lacrosse and neither of those are sponsored by the CCIW.

Augustana owns more CCIW team championships than any other school in the league with 176 total. Of those 176, the men have won 137 and 39 belong to the women.

The CCIW began to award championships in men's swimming & diving in 1947-48 and in women's swimming & diving in 1986-87. Since that time the Vikings have won eight men's titles and six women's championships.
