## **ABOUT AUGUSTANA COLLEGE**

Known for its balance of liberal arts with focus in a major field, collaborative research opportunities, competitive athletic teams and award-winning student activities programs, Augustana College is a selective independent college of the liberal arts and sciences related to the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America. The college enrolls approximately 2,500 men and women of diverse ethnic, religious and social backgrounds, from across the United States and around the world.

Augustana's athletic teams have won more championships than any other school in the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin. The Vikings own a total of 172 total team championships (135 men and 37 women) since the league began in 1946-47. Augustana is currently sixth in the nation in number of CoSIDA (College Sports Information Directors of America) Academic All-Americans produced in all sports with 125 as of June, 2008. During the 1990's the Vikings finished third, trailing only Nebraska and M.I.T.

Home to a Phi Beta Kappa academic honor society chapter since 1949, Augustana grants baccalaureate degrees in more than 60 areas of study. Along with a competitive athletic environment, student-athletes can join one or several of the school's 150 student organizations or take advantage of Augustana's wide variety of opportunities for international study. ## HEAD COACH SCOTT JOHANNSEN

Scott Johannsen will be entering his second season as the head coach of both the men and women's swim teams at Augustana in the 2009-10 school year. Johannsen replaced Greg Naumann, who resigned in June 2008 to become an assistant coach at Truman State University.

"I am pleased that Scott Johannsen has accepted the head men and women's swim coach position at Augustana," said Mike Zapoloski, director of athletics. "At the beginning of this search, it was clear that establishing a higher level of commitment and continuity from a coaching perspective was critical. I believe that Scott has the expertise and passion to be a difference-maker for the future growth of swimming at Augustana. Scott is a Quad Cities native and a well-known commodity in the regional swimming community."

Before coming to Augustana, Johannsen was head coach of the Pleasant Valley Stingrays Swim Club beginning in September of 2006. He was responsible for a club that had 150 swimmers. He has also been the owner/manager of the Samax Corporation since 1994.

Johannsen was a standout swimmer at Davenport West High School where he became the first four year varsity letterwinner in school history. He was a three time first team all-state performer in the 100 butterfly and held the school record in that event until 1996. He attended Western Illinois on a swimming scholarship and served as captain of the team. He was a two time finalist in the 100 butterfly in the Mid Continent Conference.

Prior to coaching the Stingrays, he was also the head coach of the Rock Island YMCA club team from 1987 through 1990.

He has been active in various youth programs throughout the Quad Cities and has served as the president of the Davenport Knights of Columbus and the John F. Kennedy Athletic Club. He was the vice president of the Kimberly Village Homeowner's Association in 2000-01.

## 2008-09 WOMEN'S AND MEN'S SWIMMING REVIEW

### Vikings finish fifth at CCIW Championships; women's swimmers win titles at Augustana Invitational, Eureka Invitational, and Panther Invitational; Blue & Gold earn dual meets victories over Coe, Iowa Central CC, Knox, and North Central

The Vikings finished fifth at the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin Championship meet by earning 273 points. Wheaton won the team title with 872 points and Carthage was a close second with 855 points. Illinois Wesleyan (629), Rose-Hulman (297), Millikin (232), and North Central (175) rounded out the field.

Augustana compiled several strong showings at the CCIW Championships, grabbing seven individual top 10 finishes at the three day championship meet. Senior Megan Lonergan (**Bettendorf HS, Bettendorf, Iowa**) was second in the 1650 freestyle (17:50.68), third in the 200 butterfly (2:15.75), and fourth in the 500 freestyle (5:18.77). Her times in the 1650 freestyle and 200 butterfly races set new schools records. Lonergan also set new school marks in the 500 freestyle (5:17.94) and 1000 freestyle (11:01.02) earlier in the season. Junior Sara Hlavin (**St. Viator HS, Elk Grove Village, Ill.**) added a pair of top 10 finishes, placing seventh in the 400 individual medley (5:05.24) and ninth in the 200 backstroke (2:22.22). Her clocking in the 200 backstroke is eighth best in school history. Sophomore Tonya Walter (**Prospect HS, Mount Prospect, Ill.**) grabbed the fourth spot in the one meter diving event with a score of 292.80.

The Vikings also had a trio of top-five finishes in the relay events. Freshman Jessica Fair (**Ashton-Franklin Center HS, Franklin Grove, Ill.**), sophomore Emily Cox (**Pioneer HS, Ann Arbor, Mich.**), freshman Alissa Giedd (**Freeport HS, Cedarville, Ill.**), and Hlavin combined for a fourth place performance in the 200 freestyle relay (1:45.08). Fair, Cox, Hlavin, and Lonergan were fifth in the 400 freestyle relay (3:52.35). Lonergan, Hlavin, Cox, and Fair took fourth place in the 800 freestyle relay (8:26.15).

The Blue & Gold won the four-team Panther Invitational on January 31, crowning five individual champions and one relay team. Hlavin scored two individual titles, taking top honors in the 200 backstroke (2:27.07) and the 400 individual medley (5:03.18). Lonergan was also a double winner, finishing first in the 200 butterfly (2:17.60) and the 500 freestyle (5:22.96). Cox also won an individual race, earning a top finish in the 200 freestyle (2:07.57). Fair, Giedd, Cox, and Lonergan teamed up to win the 400 freestyle relay (3:57.62).

The women also won the Eureka Invitational, grabbing the team title for the fourth year in a row. Augustana defeated five other teams and saw Lonergan win three individual races. She was first in the 200 freestyle (2:04.76), 50 butterfly (:30.25), and 100 butterfly (1:06.50). Fair earned a victory in the 50 freestyle (:26.60) and Giedd raced past the competition in the 100 freestyle (:59.86).

Augustana also won its host event, taking home the team crown at the Augustana Invitational against seven other squads. Fair won the 100 freestyle (:56.86) and Lonergan took home the title in the 200 butterfly (2:18.68) to lead the Vikings to victory. Fair, Cox, Hlavin, and Lonergan also combined to win the 800 freestyle (8:30.14).

The Vikings were 4-2 during the season in dual meets. Augustana defeated Coe, Iowa Central CC, Knox, and North Central. Augustana's only defeats came against Monmouth and Loras. The women also placed second out of eight teams at the Illinois Wesleyan Invitational, third out of four teams at the Halloween Invitational, and fourth out of eight teams at the Grinnell Invitational.

### Vikings finish sixth at CCIW men's swimming championship; men win Eureka Invitational and earn runner-up finishes at Augustana Invitational and Panther Invitational

The Vikings placed sixth at the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin Championship meet with 178 points. Carthage ran away with the team title, scoring 1,035 points to outdistance Wheaton (734). Rose-Hulman (482), Illinois Wesleyan (460), Millikin (274), and North Central (157) completed the field.

Augustana put together a solid showing at the three day championship event, compiling top-six finishes in all five relay events. Sophomore Drew Clinton (**Riverside-Brookfield HS, Brookfield, Ill.**), sophomore Joseph Waldorf (**Bloomington HS, Bloomington, Ill.**), junior Eric Zike (**Ridgeview HS, Colfax, Ill.**), and senior Dan Betz (**DeKalb HS, DeKalb, Ill.**) finished in sixth place in the 200 freestyle relay with a time of 1:31.61. Clinton, senior Jason Perine (**Plainfield South HS, Plainfield, Ill.**), Zike, and Betz took fifth place in the 400 freestyle relay with a clocking of 3:25.62. Freshman Denny Wind (**Downers Grove North HS, Downers Grove, Ill.**), junior Jacob Glimco (**Neuqua Valley HS, Naperville, Ill.**), senior Kevin Hickey (**Lincoln Way East HS, Mokena, Ill.**), and sophomore Michael Reeves (**Moline HS, Moline, Ill.**) grabbed the sixth slot in the 800 freestyle relay (8:25.75). Zike, Perine, Betz, and Clinton completed the 200 medley relay with a time of 1:43.18 and finished fifth in the race. Zike, freshman Michael Whittle (**Galesburg HS, Galesburg, Ill.**), Betz, and Clinton also combined for a sixth place showing in the 400 medley relay, hitting the finish in a time of 3:50.06.

Senior Rob Emerson (**Libertyville HS, Libertyville, Ill.**) finished second in the three meter diving event (358.95) and second in the one meter diving competition (334.95). Zike had a trio of top-16 finishes, placing 11th in the 100 backstroke (:57.17), 14th in the 200 backstroke (2:09.40), and 16th in the 100 butterfly (:57.64). Betz was 15th in the 100 butterfly with a time of :55.73.

Augustana dominated the competition on the way to a team title at the Eureka Invitational on January 24. The Vikings finished with 647 points, well ahead of runner-up Knox (162). The Blue & Gold crowned six individual champions on the day. Zike was a double winner, taking top honors in the 100 backstroke (1:01:00) and the 50 backstroke (:27.99). Wind, Whittle, Clinton, and Betz also won individual events at the meet. Wind earned first place in the 200 freestyle (2:04.99) and Whittle beat the competition in the 100 breaststroke (1:07.39). Clinton raced to a win in the 50 butterfly (:25.54) and Betz sprinted past the other swimmers in the 100 individual medley (1:00.95).

The Vikings were 3-3 on the season in dual meets. Augustana defeated Coe, Knox, and North Central with losses coming against Iowa Central CC, Monmouth, and Loras. The men finished second out of seven teams at the Augustana Invitational, second out of four teams at the Panther Invitational, fourth out of seven teams at the Illinois Wesleyan Invitational, fourth out of four teams at the Halloween Invitational, and fifth out of seven teams at the Grinnell Invitational.

## Second year head coach Scott Johansen excited to build on last season

Second year head coach Scott Johanssen is excited to "expand on what we did last year," as he heads into his second season at the helm of the Augustana swimming program. Johanssen's swimmers combined for a 7-5 dual meet record as the women were 4-2 while the men compiled a 3-3 mark. The Vikings also had a fifth place finish in the College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin championship meet from the women and a sixth place showing from the men's squad.

Fifteen letterwinners, eight for the men and seven for the women, return to the program this season and Johanssen said "all of them will play a key role." He wants "versatile swimmers who can swim different events" and feels that "several people on the team will step in and swim different events from last season."

"A very good incoming class of freshmen will also play a key role," said Johanssen. "I am looking forward to watching them develop over the next four years. There are individuals in this group that can contend for high finishes at the CCIW championship meet," he said. The women welcome eight first year swimmers to the program while four freshmen will join the men's squad.

Johanssen is pleased with the work of his captains as they are continuing to change the culture in a positive way for the program. "The young men and women are seeing consistency in our training and it should pay off this season," he said. Sara Hlavin (**St. Viator HS, Elk Grove Village, Ill.**) and Emma Moran (**Bettendorf HS, Bettendorf, Iowa**) are the senior captains for the women's team. Eric Zike (**Ridgeview HS, Colfax, Ill.**) and Jake Glimco (**Naperville Neuqua Valley HS, Naperville, Ill.**) will hold down that role for the men's team.

The Vikings are also looking forward to the team's training trip to Tampa Bay, Florida from January 1 to January 9. "We will train twice a day and our swimmers will go 10,000 to 12,000 meters per day. It will be a positive addition to our program," said Johanssen.

Another positive for the program is the stability with Johanssen returning for another season. "We can

build on things from last season and our swimmers understand my expectations going forward. We are going to push each other to improve," he said.

This year's schedule will push the Vikings as it will be more difficult than the schedule of a year ago. "We have added meets to up the competition level during the season. It should benefit us later in the year, especially at the CCIW championship meet," said Johanssen.

Augustana has also added a diving coach this season with Aimee Moylan joining the staff. She dove for four years at the University of Iowa and will work with sophomore Tonya Walter (**Prospect HS, Mt. Prospect, Ill.**) this season as well as recruit divers for future years. Walter finished fourth in the one meter diving event at the CCIW championship meet last season.

The women's team participated in six invitationals last season, winning three of them. The team finished first in the Augustana Invitational, the Eureka Invitational, and the Panther Invitational. The Blue & Gold also added a second place finish at the Illinois Wesleyan Invitational.

Hlavin had a pair of top ten finishes at the CCIW championship meet last season and finished with the eighth best time in school history in the 200 backstroke. Junior Emily Cox (**Pioneer HS, Ann Arbor, Mich.**) was also a key performer for the Vikings last season, helping the team grab a trio of top five showings at the CCIW championship meet.

The men's team also competed in six invitationals a year ago, winning the Eureka Invitational and picking up second place showings at the Augustana Invitational and the Panther Invitational. The Blue & Gold notched dual wins over Coe, Knox, and North Central.

Zike won a pair of individual titles at the Eureka Invitational and swam on four relay teams that earned top five finishes at the CCIW championship meet. Junior Drew Clinton (**Riverside Brookfield HS, Brookfield, Ill.**) was also a member of those four relay teams at the CCIW championship meet and won an individual title at the Eureka Invitational.

# The College Conference of Illinois and Wisconsin

Now in its 64<sup>th</sup> year, the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin (CCIW) enjoys a reputation as the "Best Small-College Conference in the Nation." The league was formed with nine charter members (Augustana, Carthage, Elmhurst, Illinois College, Illinois Wesleyan, Lake Forest, Millikin, North Central and Wheaton) on April 26, 1946 in Jacksonville, Illinois. Competition opened in the 1946-47 academic year as the College Conference of Illinois.

Carthage left the conference in 1952 but returned in 1961. In 1967 the name was changed to the College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin to recognize Carthage, which had moved to Kenosha, Wisconsin from Carthage, Illinois in 1962, and Carroll, which entered the league in 1955.

As is often the case with athletic conferences, CCIW membership has experienced some changes since the league's inception. After Carthage left in 1952, Illinois College withdrew the following year. Elmhurst and Wheaton left following the 1959-60 academic year. Wheaton rejoined for all sports but football in 1967 and then for football in 1970. Elmhurst rejoined in the fall of 1967 for all sports but football and for football in the 1968 season. Carroll joined officially with the 1955 spring sports seasons. Carthage returned in 1961 and North Park entered the following fall. Lake Forest dropped out at the end of the 1962-63 year. The last change in CCIW membership came following the 1991-92 season when Carroll withdrew.

Now eight members strong, the CCIW continues its tradition of athletic and academic excellence. The league sanctioned women's sports for the first time in the 1986-87 school year and Augustana participated in the first ever women's competition. That was on September 14, 1986 when the Vikings met North Central in a volleyball match that was held at Elmhurst College.

The College Conference of Illinois & Wisconsin sanctions 21 sports: baseball, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, football, men's and women's golf, men's and women's soccer, softball, men's and women's swimming, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's indoor track & field, men's and women's outdoor track & field, volleyball and wrestling.

Augustana owns more CCIW team championships than any other school in the league with 173 total. Of those 173, the men have won 135 and 38 belong to the women.

The CCIW began to award championships in men's swimming & diving in 1947-48 and in women's swimming & diving in 1986-87. Since that time the Vikings have won eight men's titles and six women's championships.
